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Education in Schools of Uzbekistan on the Basis of Foreign Experience

Today it is the same fact that tomorrow one of the bright prospects of our motherland first of all describes it as closely related to the educational system and the upbringing we give our children.In school educational institutions, the roots of development spread a wide vein. Development cannot be imagined without the advancement of Science and education. Providing deep theoretical knowledge skills and Amli skills to the learners as well as their general education and professional knowledge is a system aimed at developing skills and abilities to form skills today, in the schools of our country, on the basis of foreign experience, further development of the educational sphere, improving the quality of use of Information Technologies, radical reform of educational, textbooks were prescribed within the framework of the laws that it is necessary to comply with world standards of teaching aids. Enacted by the legislature on May 19, 2020, consists of the education legislation of 2020 by the Senate. The provisions of the international treaty apply if the Treaty of the peoples of the Republic of Uzbekistan establishes different provisions not provided for by the educational legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan. School education and scientific research activities of several popular developed programs in the world, with the system of international educational programs, the generalization of the forms of educational processes of us is one of the main foundations of development. Opening the door to a wide range of opportunities for the innovative development of educational and scientific activities. Education is a systematic process aimed at the formation of their consciousness, spiritual and moral value and worldview on the basis of a clear goal and a social historical-experimental effective foreign experience to make a comprehensive decision of the younger generation. Learning the process of obtaining knowledge is the process of generating skills and skills, the main means of preparing a person for life to work. In the process of education, knowledge is mastered and upbringing is carried out. In our country, a huge amount of funds is allocated by the state to the field of education from year to year. The construction of new modern schools, the renovation of which is carried out with material technologies. Programs of training of educators in the field of cognitive education for innovative activities all changes are taking place, in which the criteria of professional skill meet the standard requirements of international education. During these years, President Shavkat Mirziyoyev approved the national program for the development of school education in accordance with the state program on the implementation of the development strategy of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

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The formation of educational and skills of school students in our country, their education in the spirit of loyalty to our national and universal values, preparation of pedagogical qualitative composition of the teaching profession and knowledge, improvement of textbooks and educational methodological complexes on the basis of the requirements of the time is being developed to the extent that the school meets the world standards of educational institutions. Our president's appeal to the Supreme Assembly in January of this year said that school curricula improve on the basis of advanced foreign experience to process curricula and subjects, adapting them to international standards emphasized the need to improve the quality of textbooks and literature. Improving the material technical support in schools determined the tasks of international modern pedagogical technology in the educational process]. In Uzbekistan, the school is in the state property of asosasan, in which education and knowledge is free. Public education-introduced by the state at the national level by law for the children of the country. The schools are currently about 11,000 with the following educational law orders following them.

- Democratization of the school system;
- Achieve high success in the field of Education.
- > Study, application of international educational experiences;
- Giving modern knowledge
- > Training of mature specialists, pedagogical personnel

In addition to educational schools, there are schools that differ from each other, the President's school is a school named after our great allies, the Timurid School, specializing in foreign languages. The training center school has MONO training center schools and private schools, which are mainly mastered in the short term (C1 B2) and are preparing for life by teaching the necessary professions in training courses: sewing, accountant, computer worker, programmer, Cook, master, auto mechanic, electronic and household services, etc.

We have given an example of the fact that students of the creation schools named after Muhammad Yusuf had early access to the certificates of the agency for the assessment of knowledge and skills in the direction of the OSCE. From February 1, 2025, President Shavkat Mirziyoyev issued an order that from February 1, 2025, pedagogical personnel with the relevant level Uzbek language and literature certificate received in the National Assessment System, who are teachers of Uzbek language (state language) in general and secondary educational institutions in the preschool and school education system, will be paid an additional monthly amount of 52% in relation to their definition rate. Also, let's say, as an example of educators today, the recognition of their work in the honor service has always been highly appreciated. From time immemorial, our people looked at the teachers of science at a higher level. "the teacher is as great as your father " is also recognized in the folk proverb, the traditions of the school and the teacher have always been highly revered by our people. Indeed, in our country, the emphasis on educational education is not inferior to developed countries, we can admit. We can say proud to see the youth of our homeland in world arenas. Having studied the developed styles of countries such as developed countries: Germany, America, Japan, Korea, Finland, we would reach the sphere of developed countries if we could harmonize schools with our own schools. In foreign countries and in our country, education is a socio-political process, the system of which actively affects the domestic policy of the country.

If we go according to the system of the school of foreign countries, the Japanese educational system has developed rapidly in World War II, mainly in the provision of knowledge to the upbringing faithful to their patriotic feelings, etiquette. The Japanese school consists of elementary junior and senior high schools with academic year 2 yo 3 semesters the school year starts on April 1, study days last 240 days until March 31 next year, class time starts at 830 in the morning and ends at 1530. The Japanese state also mastered advanced innovative pedagogically complex work experiences, such as America,

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Germany, Korea, without being limited to only national traditions. South Korea also has a progressive education system, and school operations are tightly controlled. The academic year is Semester 2 from March to February. The primary school offers 9 subjects. Special importance is attached to the teaching of foreign language and Korean. Arithmetic and social sciences are also taught. In the middle class, the subjects will be increased until March 4th. Since they are compulsory to learn a foreign language and classical Chinese, the bulk of the population speaks a foreign language. There were also over 600 vocational schools.

In Finland, too, the education system is in the top five of the best 'education systems'in the world. Schools in the country are primarily public schools, with a single requirement for educational levels. The academic year is taught for 12 years, from the age of 5-8 to 18-19 years. Class days are 80 days, from September to January.

The American education system program is considered the best developed educational programs. The teaching method is also different from that of Western countries. They focus more on practical knowledge than theoretical knowledge. The schools provide bialn rooms with the latest equipment with a technical-technology base. Up to Grade 9, the focus is on the natural and Exact Sciences.

Particular attention is paid to the development of students 'ability to think logically. Classes are held aimed at solving problems and developing creative thinking skills.

Research is being carried out on participation in international research of PISA, SMART and TALIS conducted by the organization of Economic Cooperation and development of the Republic of Uzbekistan and on quality assessment of Education under the supervision of the quality of education and the state inspection.

In Uzbekistan, the process of training on the basis of the Singapore education system is carried out in recent years. Curricula in schools are being adapted to the Singapore model to allow students to gain indepth and systematic knowledge. Modern pedagogical methods and innovative approaches for teachers are used in the teaching process. This helps to ensure active student participation. The implementation of the educational system is aimed at improving the quality of education and ensuring that students receive knowledge that meets global standards. This line continues and is expected to expand further in the future.

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
